Loyola Law School's July 2008 Bar Passage Jumps 9%

Los Angeles – Loyola Law School Los Angeles' California Bar passage rate for the July 2008 exam was 87 percent – an increase of nine percentage points over July 2007 and 12 percentage points over July 2006 among first-time takers. Loyola also counted the most passers – 323 – of any California law school, according to recently announced results.

"We have been working hard to better prepare our students for the Bar exam, and it's clear those efforts have paid off," said Dean Victor J. Gold.
