

Loyola Law School Los Angeles Named One of Best Law Schools by the *Princeton Review*

October 5, 2006—Los Angeles—Loyola Law School Los Angeles was named one of the nation's most outstanding law schools by the *Princeton Review*. Out of 170 law schools, Loyola ranked 5th for "Best Overall Academic Experience," among the Universities of Chicago, Virginia, Pennsylvania and Michigan and Stanford, Georgetown, Northwestern, Brigham and Young and Washington and Lee. Additionally, Loyola Law ranked 3rd for "Professors Rock" and 6th for "Best Environment for Minority Students."

Loyola Law School scored a 97 in the academic experience rating, a 97 in the professors interesting rating and a 96 in the professors accessible rating. The profile highlights Loyola's "reputation for producing renowned litigators," the "abundant opportunities to acquire practical researching, writing and courtroom skills through extensive connections to the judicial system and excellent trial and appellate advocacy programs" and the "unique opportunities to study abroad."

On being recognized as one of the country's outstanding law schools, Loyola Dean David Burcham said, "This profile recognizes some of Loyola Law School's outstanding attributes. I am pleased that the hard work of our faculty, students, staff and alumni was recognized."
