What is it?

- Represent a client in an appeal (civil or immigration case) before the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit
- Draft an opening brief during the fall semester, draft a reply brief during the spring semester, and deliver oral argument before the end of the spring semester
- Work with a Loyola student teammate and under the supervision of a skilled practitioner
- 2 units in the fall semester and 2 units in the spring semester

Who is eligible?

- Students who have completed at least 58 units (typically, third-year day and fourth-year evening students)
- Must have advanced research and writing skills, an interest in appeals, and a strong work ethic

How to apply?

- Wait for an email requesting applications in April
