We can:



Help you understand the process for reporting to police.



Provide accompaniment to ongoing meetings with Law Enforcement Agencies.



Ensure that you receive proper notice of actions associated with the criminal case.



Help protect your rights as a crime victim, such as the right to privacy and restitution.



Assess your eligibility for other remedies, including immigration benefits (U-Visa, VAWA, T-Visa).



Identify your options for civil claims associated with damages resulting from the crime.



Help you develop a safety plan and provide referrals for services .
