January 2026 Interession Billing Information and Tuition Liability Policy

- Charges will be posted on November 21, 2025. **Scholarships do not apply to Interession.**
- Payment for Interession is due on December 20, 2025 (There is no payment plan for Interession). Students who miss the payment deadline or have not applied for financial aid will be dropped from Interession courses.
- Students wishing to apply for federal direct loans for Interession courses should complete the Interession Financial Aid Application available on the [Financial Aid website](#).
- To qualify for Federal Direct Loans, students must be enrolled at least half-time (Interession and Spring 2026 combined).

Important: It is the student's responsibility to complete all loan arrangements by the date established by the Financial Aid Office or be prepared to pay for their Interession balance by December 20, 2025. No credit cards are accepted for tuition/fees for any term.

Liability Policy: Participants will have until Sunday, 1/4/2026 to drop Interession courses to have the charges reversed from their account. **Students who drop out of Interession on or after Monday, January 5, 2026 are liable for 100% of the charges.**
